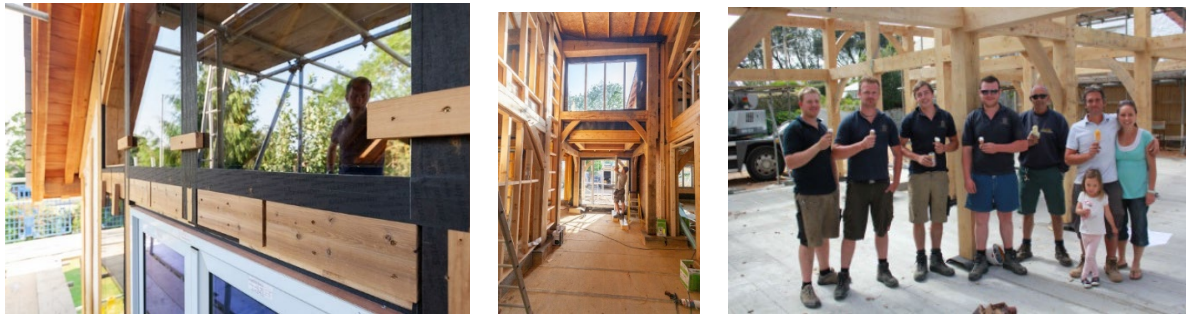

GENERAL

- A general understanding of common construction systems.
- Softwood timber frames.
- Masonry.
- Common services (plumbing etc.).

READING AND UNDERSTANDING DRAWINGS

- You will be able to take measurements and set out work from scaled drawings supplied.
- You will be able to work within agreed tolerances shown on the drawings (eg. +/- 2mm) in both plumb and level.

COMMUNICATE CLEARLY AND CONCISELY

- You will be able to provide basic instructions and guidance to the site team.
- You will identify problems and be able to discuss these with the designer / workshop / project manager.
- You will be able to record and carry out verbal instructions from the designer / workshop / project manager; both on site and over the phone.

USE HAND AND POWER TOOLS

- Drills.
- Routers.
- Chop Saws.
- Circular Saws.
- Nail Guns (both air and cartridge).
- You will have your own hand tools.
